ADENANTHOS FLAT OUT

A prostrate grower with beautiful texture and foliage colour. The new growth is tinged bronze. A great groundcover for spilling over embankments and rockeries. Performs best in full sun and well drained soil. Moderate water requirements.

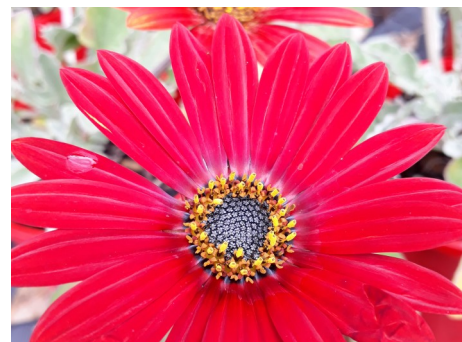
H 0.1-0.3m W 0.75-1m



ACACIA SPRINGTIME CASCADE

A prostrate Acacia to 30-40cm. The blue-green foliage is well complemented by clusters of golden flowers in Spring. Great groundcover for suppressing weeds and covering embankments. Position in full sun or light shade. Low water requirements once established.

H 0.3m W 3m



ARCTOTIS BLOOD RED

A very hardy clumping plant with elegant silver foliage. Long stems of blood red flowers reaching 10cm in diameter; flower on mass throughout the warmer months. Prefers a sunny position. Low maintenance plant with low water requirements once established.

GROUND COVERS



BRACHYSCOME PACIFIC REEF

Vibrant purple/pink flowers are the striking feature of this Brachyscome. It has deep green, divided foliage with a compact, suckering growth habit. Prefers a sunny to lightly shaded position. Low water requirements once established.

H 0.3m W 0.5m



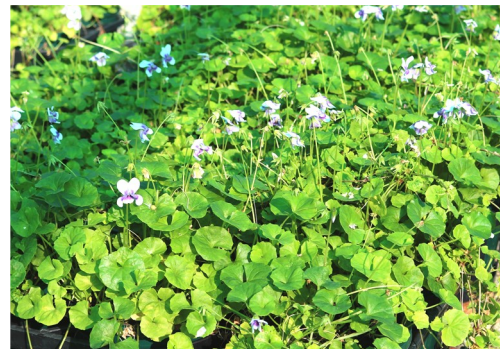
ERIGERON SPINDRIFT (D)

A neat, dome shaped plant with a beautiful display of white/pink/red daisy flowers from Spring to Autumn.

Plant in a sunny position in well drained soil.

Frost tolerant. Low water requirements when established.

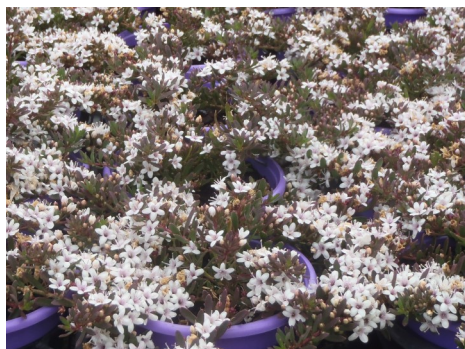
H 0.2m W 0.5m



VIOLA HEDERACEA

A pretty groundcover for shaded areas with round leaves and small white flowers. In low traffic areas it can be used as a lawn substitute. It performs well under trees and looks great planted amongst paths and near ponds. Excellent weed suppressor. Prefers moist soils.

H 0.1-0.2m W 0.3-1m



MYOPORUM PARV. PURPUREA

An easy care groundcover with dense, purple-toned foliage. Small white flowers cover the foliage in Spring to Summer. Excellent for out-competing weeds and using as a lawn substitute in low traffic areas.

Low water requirements once established.

H 0.2-0.3m W 1-3m



SCAEVOLA BONDI BLUE

A strong grower with a ground hugging habit with dense mid-green foliage and purple/blue fan flowers during the warmer months.

Requires minimal watering once established.

Well drained soil in full sun to partly shaded position.

H 0.25m W 0.6m



WESTRINGIA MUNDI™ (D)

A tough ground cover with a mass of white flowers. It can be left unpruned making it perfect for roadsides and plant and forget areas. Prefers full sun to part shade and once established requires only minimal watering in summer and extended dry periods.

H 0.4-0.5m W 1.5m
