Blue RidgeTM has broad powdery blue-grey upright foliage which darkens green as it ages. Mature plants will have a mixture of blue and green foliage. Best suited to free draining soil. Suitable for both residential and commercial projects.

Frosty Top() has lightly weeping, fine greygreen foliage with silver-frosted new growth. Tiny yellow flowers appear in the foliage in Spring and Summer. H 15-25cm x 40-60cm Frosty Top is similar to Lomandra Wingarra



Lime Tuff() is a compact variety with fine lime green strappy leaves with small yellow flower spikes in Summer. Great for urban landscapes where there are height restrictions. Requires minimal maintenance once established. H 70cm x 50-70cm



Little Con forms a neat, rounded mound of lime green. Hardy and easy to grow, it looks great mass planted as a ground cover as well as a being a tough edging choice for low maintenance areas. Ideal for coastal regions, rockeries, roundabouts and median strips.

Drought tolerant once established.

Lomandra Seascape is a small grower with contrasting blue-grey foliage. Its graceful weeping habit makes it ideal for containers on patios and planting en masse.

TanikaTM LM300 (b) is an improved, compact form of longifolia with fine strappy leaves that are soft to touch. It is low maintenance with minimal water requirements making it ideal for large scale projects including roadsides and median strips.

Tolerates windy conditions. H 50-60cm x 65cm



Little Lime is a smaller, more

Little Lime is a smaller, more compact form of Lime Tuff. It has finer foliage that stays lush year around. Useful for low borders, planting en masse and contrast in land-scapes. Once established is frost tolerant and has minimal water requirements.

Nyalla™ LM400() is a semicompact fine leaved form of longifolia. It requires minimal maintenance making it great for erosion control, windy sites and coastal conditions. It has small yellow flowers in Spring. Popular for median strips, roundabouts and verges. H 80-90cm x 80-90cm

Verday LL364() is a compact, fine-leaved form of Lomandra. This native grass thrives where most other plants struggle. Small cream flower spikes appear thorugh spring and summer. Tolerates both sandy and clay soils. Drought, frost and coastal tolerant.
