

LOMANDRA

Lomandra are extremely tough Australian native grasses. Some watering is required to establish them as is the occasional water during long dry spells. They make excellent landscaping plants creating contrast in structural shapes. When choosing a Lomandra consider foliage colour and how big they will grow to suit the site.



CRACKERJACK™ (b) The fine flowing foliage has a softening effect against hard surfaces. With it's wide spread, Crackerjack is useful for covering large garden beds and long borders. Full sun to part shade.

Crackerjack is similar to Lomandra Seascape



DALLIANCE (b) is a tidy long-fofolia cultivar with upright green foliage. Tiny yellow flowers appear in the foliage in Spring and Summer. Tolerates drought & frost.

Full sun to part shade.

H 60cm W 50cm



EVERGREEN BABY™ (b) is a compact plant with fine foliage and yellow flowers in Spring. It is small and tough, tolerating frost, dryness and periodic wet feet.

Full sun to part shade.

H 40-45cm W 45cm



FINE 'N DANDY™ is a dense, tufting plant with narrow bright green foliage. In Spring to Summer upright stems of scented yellow flowers are on show. It is the ideal plant for borders, edging and containers and is both butterfly attracting and frost tolerant.

Full sun to part shade.

H 100-120cm W 45-60cm



KEIRA™ is one of the smaller growing Lomandra. The bright green narrow leaves form a dense rounded shape. Plant as borders or in beds in full sun or part shade under trees.

H 30-40cm W 30-40cm



FROSTY TOP (b) has lightly weeping, fine grey-green foliage with silver-frosted new growth. Tiny yellow flowers appear in the foliage in Spring and Summer.

Full sun to part shade.

H 15-25cm W 40-60cm

Frosty Top is similar to Lomandra Wingarra

LIME JET™ (b) forms a large, upright, arching clump of lime green leaves which contrasts well against darker foliaged plants and brightens shaded areas. Best suited to free draining soils.

Full sun to part shade.

H 1m W 1m



LIME WAVE (b) has long, bright green, fine foliage with a weeping habit. Spikes of cream yellow flowers are borne along the stems during Spring and Summer. Highly ornamental, great for cascading over walls or tall pots.

Full sun to part shade.

H 70cm W 70cm



LIME TUFF (b) has fine lime green strappy leaves with small yellow flower spikes in Summer. Great for urban landscapes where there are height restrictions.

Full sun to part shade.

H 30-50cm W 30-50cm



LITTLE CRICKET™ (b) has a compact semi-upright habit with weeping tips. It produces dense clusters of scented flowers in late Spring. Tolerates most soil types and frosty Winters to dry or humid Summers.

Full sun to part shade.

H 40cm W 30cm



SHARA™ (b) has fine slightly tinged blue-grey foliage. In Spring it has masses of yellow flowers that sit above the foliage. It tolerates frost and a wide variety of soil types.

Full sun to part shade.

H 40cm W 50cm



TILGA™ The narrow green, vigorous growth forms a weeping rounded shape as the plant matures. Suited to dry sandy soils or mulched clay. Full sun to part shade.

H 50-70cm W 50cm
Tilga is similar to Lomandra Tanika



VERDAY (b) is a tough native grass that thrives where most other plants struggle. It has green semi-pendulous foliage. Tolerates both sandy and clay soils, as well as being drought, frost and coastal tolerant.

Full sun to part shade.
H 60 W 1m
